

Lytle Ranch Preserve Reservation Information

In order to more effectively provide access to and use of the Lytle Ranch Preserve, we have implemented the following expectations and fee schedule. Due to research activities, academic programs, construction, and repairs, specific areas of the preserve may be closed at any time.

1. All scheduling of the Lytle Ranch Preserve facilities must be handled through the Monte L. Bean Life Science Museum (801-422-5052 or secretary.museum@byu.edu).
2. The campground will accommodate up to 20 people.
3. Use of the picnic pavilion is by reservation only.
4. Use of the campground is by reservation only (**Note:** The campground has 3 campsites).
5. Educational/research groups are given priority consideration for reserving preserve facilities.
6. The preserve is not available for family reunions.
7. Restrooms and showers are available for use by all guests. Please clean up after yourself.
8. Camping fees are as follows:
 - a. BYU groups \$10.00/night/campsite
 - b. Non-BYU groups \$15.00/night/campsite

Rules for Lytle Preserve -Note: see the "Use and Fee Schedule" document for more details (mlbean.byu.edu)

1. No consumption of tobacco or alcohol on preserve property.
2. No use of firearms on the preserve property.
3. No ATVs except those required for operation of the preserve.
4. No horses, except those required for operation of the preserve.
5. Fires in designated areas only unless seasonably prohibited (check with the manager).
6. Garbage generated by visitors must be hauled out.
7. Quiet time is from 11:00pm to 6:00am.
8. No collection of specimens without prior written permission from the administration of the Monte L. Bean Life Science Museum.
